


Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL)


2020 Course Completions by semester



2020 Course completions in total





2020 Course Completions in total VS non-completion (other)






VCAL Pathways by program










VCAL Pathways in total

Student Satisfaction Survey

From data gathered in the AQTF 2020 Student Satisfaction Survey, VCAL students rated their program at an average of 69.9 overall satisfaction across all areas. This was slightly down on 2019 overall satisfaction rating of 70.3. The benchmark for all school and program areas was 70% satisfaction.

Students satisfaction would have been impacted by constant changes to the mode of delivery during COVID-19 lockdown restrictions and physical distancing which required rotation of groups to maintain safe student numbers on campus.

The continuous improvement activities that were undertaken in 2020 (and continue in 2021) were a result of student and staff formal and informal evaluations and feedback; and actions resulting from the re-registration and audit conducted by the VCAA and VRQA.
