

Melbourne Polytechnic Registration Self-Assurance Review – Australian Skills Quality Authority

Melbourne Polytechnic (MP) (TOID 3075) is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) under the <u>National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011</u> to provide nationally recognised training and assessment services and to issue Australian Skills Quality Authority (AQF) certification documentation for the training products listed on its scope of registration.

The institute's regulatory body for vocational education and training (VET) and its registration is the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA).

ASQA conducted a review of Melbourne Polytechnic's self-assurance systems and practices, primarily focused on quality student outcomes, self-assurance and continuous improvement, in response to an application for renewal of registration. ASQA also requested unique evidence relevant to the Institute's operations, specifically relating to evidence of risks management.

Quality Self-Assurance Risks Outcome levels of the provider: Low

Audit or further clarification required: No further action required.

Based on the findings of this review, ASQA has confidence that MP has suitable self-assurance systems and practices for delivering quality training and assessment, in line with the requirements under the legislation and therefore, a further review was not conducted and renewal of registration was granted.

Registration was approved by ASQA for the maximum seven-year period to 30 June 2029.
