


Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL)

Completion and Destination Data



Student Enrolment Profile




2021 Course Completion by semester







VCAL Student Pathways by year



2021 Student attendance




2021 Average Attendance in total






2021 Student attrition by course

Student Satisfaction Survey

From data gathered in the AQTF 2021 Student Satisfaction Survey, VCAL students rated their program at an average of 80% overall satisfaction across all areas. This was an increase up from 70.4% in 2020. The benchmark for all school and program areas was 70% satisfaction. The 2021 response rate to the AQTF survey increased from 33% in 2020 to 60% in 2021.

Students satisfaction would have been impacted by constant changes to the mode of delivery during COVID-19 lockdown restrictions and physical distancing which required rotation of groups to maintain safe student numbers on campus.

The continuous improvement activities that were undertaken in 2021 (and continue in 2022) were a result of student and staff formal and informal evaluations and feedback; and actions resulting from the re-registration and audit conducted by the VCAA and VRQA.
