– Riverina, New South Wales

A lively bouquet of pears and apples leads to a palate that is crisp and clean, with a pleasant medium dry finish. This is a great value example that can be enjoyed as a refreshing aperitif but will also compliment light bodied meals.

DALFARRAS PROSECCO

– Goulburn River, Central Victoria

This Italian style sparkling wine delivers aromas of lemon, pear and tropical fruits. The mouthfeel is very nice with fresh acidity and fine bead structure to the bubbles within. The label depicting the Japonica Blossom is designed by Rosa Purbrick, wife of chief wine maker at Tahbilk Winery (Alister Purbrick). It's a quality drop under the flag of Tahbilk.

VALLATE PROSECCO NV

– Veneto, Italy

Rightly evanescent, with a fine and persistent perlage. Pale straw yellow with greenish highlights. Intense, fruity with a rich scent of apple, lemon and grapefruit. It has pronounced aroma of wisteria in bloom and acacia flowers. It has a pleasantly acidity, fresh flavour. Full-bodied, it has a pleasant and harmonious taste characteristic.

ALEXANDER HILL FRUITY LEXIA
- Yeringa, New South Wales

This is a fruit driven wine with light carbonation. It's made using the Muscat grape, which typically delivers aromas of citrus, orange blossom, and honeysuckle. There some acidity to balance out the fruitiness.

TAHBILK RIESLING
- Goulburn River, Central Victoria

This example has a gentle, light body with floral aromas. It's not "steely" like others from around the country, offering a textured palate, with good acidity and citrus flavours. It is "moreish" and would compliment lighter dishes and seafood well.

DAL ZOTTO PINOT GRIGIO
- King Valley, Victoria

This family owned winery is located in an ideal location for growing Italian grape varieties. Pinot Grigio is easy drinking with flavours of fresh lime and pear with a hint of nuttiness. There is a nice textural mouthfeel which allows it to match well with seafood and lighter dishes.

821 SOUTH SAUVIGNON BLANC
- Marlborough, New Zealand

"821" refers to the number of snow capped mountains that exist in the south island of New Zealand. Such mountains protect the vineyards in Marlborough allowing a longer ripening period. This wine exhibits ripe citrus and sweeter tasting fruits with a lashing of acidity to balance. A good example of cool climate sauvignon blanc.

DEVIL'S LAIR "THE HIDDEN CAVE"
CHARDONNAY
– Margaret River, Western Australia

Margaret River is well known for its world class chardonnay wines. This Chardonnay has aromas of white peach, lemon citrus and melon. There is subtle oak integration which provides creaminess and richness to the palate. Great with white meats, seafood and rich soft cheeses.

XANADU CIRCA 77 CHARDONNAY
– Margaret River, Western Australia

Xanadu is a top producer in the region delivering great Chardonnay to the nation. This example shows aromas of fresh pears, apples and grapefruit. The palate offers a refreshing, crisp and dry taste with citrus notes. A slightly creamy texture is also evident as a result of some oak contact and lees stirring.

– McLaren Vale, South Australia

A blend of Cinsault, Sangiovese and Sagrantino result in a delicious drop giving aromas of strawberry, raspberry and cherries. The wine will further evolve in the glass to show a layer of citrus fruit. The finish is dry and crisp giving nice balance to the wine. This one is certified organic and vegan friendly.

YERING STATION "LITTLE YERING" PINOT NOIR
– Yarra Valley, Victoria

Using fruit from the renowned Yarra Valley region, this wine delivers aromas of bramble (berry fruit), strawberry and red cherry. The palate offers fresh red fruits and spicy notes, with a hint of blood orange zest. The finish is smooth and silky.

MUDHOUSE PINOT NOIR
– Central Otago, New Zealand

The Central Otago region is located in the middle of New Zealand's south island. It is world renowned for producing high quality, richer, full bodied examples of pinot noir. This is no exception with notes of bold cherries, juicy red fruit, spice and oak.

PREECE SHIRAZ
– Heathcote, Victoria

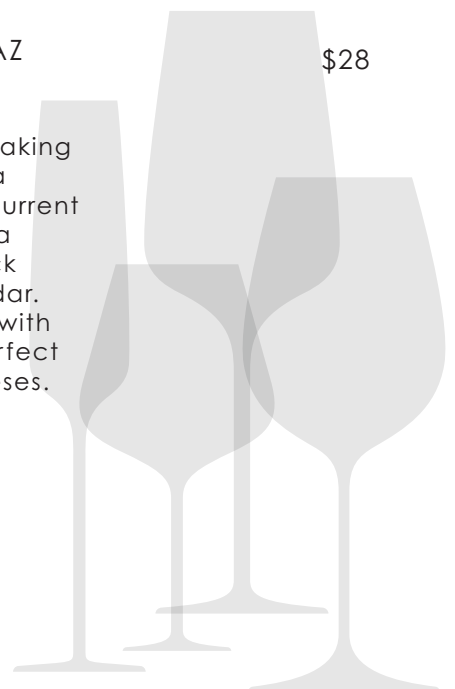

Heathcote represents a region from which some of Australia's best examples of shiraz are produced. The red soil unique to the area produces a fruit driven style, that is rich and smooth. The Preece shiraz offers a bouquet of licorice, blackberries, chocolate and spice. The palate is smooth with layers of plum, ripe blackberries and licorice. It's well balanced with soft tannins build and the finish has length.

JOHN GEHRIG 'Snart's Block' SHIRAZ
2015 – King Valley, Victoria

Snarts block refers to the original winemaking pioneer, Robert Snart, who established a vineyard & winery back in 1860 on the current site. This central Victorian example has a complex bouquet of black pepper, black olive, dried meat and spicy vanillan cedar. The palate is "chewy" and has richness with black cherry, licorice and pepper. A perfect wine for red meat dishes and hard cheeses.

BETHANY "FIRST VILLAGE" GSM
– Barossa Valley, South Australia

This is a medium bodied style which has its origins in the Rhone Valley in France. It's always a blend of Grenache, which contributes acidity and spiced red fruits; Syrah (shiraz), which provides tannin, colour and black pepper notes; and Mourvedre, which supports gamey or meaty flavours. It's silky smooth with a great mouth feel.

PAULETT WINES CABERNET MERLOT
– Clare Valley, South Australia

The blending of cabernet sauvignon and merlot is a well established and highly successful practice the world over. In the partnership, Merlot enhances the fruit flavours of the wine and gives a juicy mouthfeel, while Cabernet provides tannin, acidity and dark fruit flavours. The end result is a medium to full bodied wine that has it all! – fruit, spice, velvet texture, some tannin and acidity. This one is also vegan friendly.

TAHBILK CABERNET SAUVIGNON
– Nagambie Lakes, Central Victoria

A structured wine from one of the oldest family owned wineries in Australia. The estate is also certified as carbon neutral. This cabernet has aromas of intense blackberry, spice, black olive and dried herbs. The black olive character is unique to cabernet from that area. The palate is medium bodied and fresh, delivering flavours of blackcurrant and black olive. The wine has medium tannins and the finish is dry and long. Great with red meat dishes and hard cheeses.

MITCHELTON BLACKWOOD PARK
BOTRYTIS RIESLING – Goulburn River,
Central Victoria (375ml)

Deep gold in colour and bursting with aromas of candied citrus, dried fruits and lime marmalade. The palate is thick and luscious and resplendent with flavours of ginger spice, raisins and honeysuckle.

TAHBILK CANE CUT MARSANNE
– Nagambie Lakes, Central Victoria
